Job Title: NURSES STUDENT STAFFWORKER

Reporting to: Head of Allied Professions Ministries

Working with: Nursing Student Reps, Christian Nurses & Midwives (CNM) Council, CMF Student Staff Team and volunteers/interns and UCCF regional teams

Location: London office / Peripatetic London & SE England

Time Commitment: full time (10 sessions per week)

ROLE PURPOSE

Furthering the aims of the Fellowship (evangelism, discipleship, mission and values) by pioneering a new ministry amongst nursing, midwifery and allied health professional (AHP) students in London and Southeast England, with the long term aim of developing a network of local Christian student groups throughout the UK.

KEY ACCOUNTABILITIES

- Identifying, recruiting, training and supporting student representatives and leaders in each training institution
- Attending, speaking/preaching, leading Bible studies, etc. at nursing and AHP Christian student meetings.
- Encouraging individuals within these groups in discipleship, witness, and work, with a particular focus on potential future leaders and new Christians.
- Help to plan and organise national nursing and AHP student conferences, speaking at and attending other local, regional, and national nursing, AHP and CMF activities to promote and expand ministry.
- Commissioning, co-editing and/or writing student literature and articles for *CNM News*, and writing for other publications as appropriate.
- Some involvement in promoting and facilitating world mission, through encouraging student electives with Christian healthcare mission organisations, encouraging mission support and recruitment amongst Christian students, and encouraging links with international students.
- Encouraging and supporting UK student involvement with international Christian events, including Nurses Christian Fellowship International (NCFI) conferences and other international Christian events as appropriate.
- Along with the Head of Allied Professions, contribute to the Allied Professions Sub-Committee, Christian Nurses and Midwives (CNM) Council and the leadership of other Christian AHP groups as appropriate.
- Identify and support student representatives at CNM Council (and other networks as appropriate)
- Participation in CMF Student Staff Workers' team days and conference calls as appropriate.

 - The London and SE England UCCF regional teams, and in particular those working in nursing and other AHP linked CUs
 - Other organisations or churches involved in student ministry as appropriate.
